Outreach Team	Schools
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Target and goal setting (in liaison with SENCO, Pupil, Class teacher, 1:1) for Inclusion in the curriculum (classroom practice, differentiation advice) * Advice on and/ or loan of Assistive technology (AT) for practical inclusion in classroom activities and access to IT. * Advice on using augmentative and alternative communication (AAC) to access the curriculum * Support in assessment of progress * Support and training in daily care needs * Moving and handling/postural awareness and training (small charge for this) * Disability awareness training * Liaising with other professionals and signposting to other services * Parental support * Attending meetings (where possible) to contribute towards EHC's, ESCO meetings etc 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * To provide recent reports (e.g. from health professionals, Ed Pysch, other outreach services) * To outline key targets for the pupil based on the Outreach teams roles and responsibilities opposite * For the Class Teacher and/or the SENCO to attend meetings with outreach staff alongside 1:1 and pupil. (We understand this can be difficult but it really is imperative that a teacher attends , even if for a short briefing) * When targets are agreed between the Outreach team, school and pupil, it is expected that the school will provide evidence on those targets so that progress can be discussed at the next visit. * To pass on reports to any relevant agencies
